Topic

In history our topic is 'Who were our greatest explorers?' We will be learning the stories of 3 significant explorers from the past with a focus on 'what made them so great?' In science we will be learning about plants and will be encouraging the children to investigate the plants and trees around them.

Maths

This half term we will be learning to count in 2's, 5's and 10's, studying 3D shape & recognizing coins. We will also be learning to tell the time, specifically using the vocabulary o'clock and half past and will appreciate any reinforcement of this using your clocks and watches at home.



We know that reading is very important to children's learning throughout the subjects and Year One is a key year for developing early reading skills. Children will bring home a new reading book every 3 - 5 school days (dependent upon the group that they are in). We will be most grateful if you can continue to support reading at home as much as possible, just a little every day will have an immeasurably positive impact on your child's progress in school, just a few pages per night is great.
